## Results of June 9 Public Hearing

Dear Fairmont Butte Motorsports Park Supporters,

As always, I thank you for on-going support of Fairmont Butte Motorsports Park.

Although we continue to move quickly and surely to comply with the County's requirements for our project, it doesn't always work the other way around.

This last hearing on June 9 was supposed to move us closer to approval. Instead, the County continued the hearing to August 18 to give it time to complete its findings regarding the project and to address a water rights lawsuit against the County that affects a number of projects in the Antelope Valley, including ours. The lawsuit has nothing to do with our project specifically, but we must wait for the County to address the issue.

We remain confident that our project is on track and expect to move forward as previously planned on the new August hearing date.

The continued hearing will be held on Wednesday, August 18, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. in the Los Angeles County Hall of Records, Room 150, at 320 West Temple Street, Los Angeles.
