Dear Fairmont Butte Motorsports Park Supporters,

I would like to thank all of you that have supported Fairmont Butte Motorsports Park with your letters and e-mails to the County of Los Angeles and those that attended the hearings—especially the one held on Saturday February 6th in Lancaster.

The fact that many of you left the crowded room at our request to satisfy the Fire Department and to accommodate those in opposition that could not get in, was very impressive to me and very effective for the Planning Commission. If the hearing was continued to a future date in Lancaster as demanded by the opposition it could have been a serious setback to the program. Your presence at the meeting just for the head count was the most important part. You did your part and were spared the remaining hearing.

We have a T-shirt commemorating the February 6th hearing which we planned to distribute after the hearing but with the confusion at the time many supporters did not get one. During the hearing, a few supporters stayed at our request to comment to the Planning Commission. Unfortunately, the opposition testimony was repetitive and often quite misleading. While we are held to the County's very high standard of truth and accuracy, the opposition can make false statements with no apparent accountability. As you might imagine, this is more than frustrating after eight years of hard work and many dollars invested in the project.
